### **MODERN DANCE AND COMPOSITION**

Students will master modern dance skills including energy, strength, flexibility and phrasing, while developing their own personal movement style. In addition to Pilato's technique, the dancers will also explore the techniques of Jose Limon, Catherine Dunham and Alvin Ailey. During the second half of the course, there will be in an intense focus on student choreography and Loco-Motion repertoire to prepare for performances in various New York City venues.
